## How Will the eBook Be Formatted?

The eBook will be split into several categories including: Paintings, Projects, Techniques  
Submissions will fit into one of these categories.

## What is required from each contributor?

Each contributor will submit the following using the online form provided:

- Title of Contribution - this can be the name of the piece of artwork you are sharing, name of project or name of technique.
- Photo of painting, project or technique
- Materials List (include brands and colors of inks, tools, techniques, etc.)
- 500 words or less explanation of process
- Artist Name
- Artist Bio (50 words or less)
- Artist Website Address (or other web property)
- Instagram profile (if applicable)
- FB page URL (if applicable)

## Optional Video Resource Option

If you want to create a video of your painting, project or technique, we can link to the video from the project page. All videos would need to be hosted on the official **Alcohol Ink Art Community YouTube Channel**. **Credits will be given to contributor with links to website and other social media channels. If Contributor has his/her own YouTube channel, a link and reference will be provided in video description.** Videos **cannot be in lieu of** project descriptions and above requirements. Contributors must still provide the details required above.

## Ethics

All submissions should be of your own work. Most techniques and processes with alcohol ink are not eligible for a patent, trademark or copyright. With this said, please do not blatantly copy someone else's work or presentation/process verbatim. That's just unethical. We understand that many of us use some of the same processes and this some duplication is expected as we all work in the same medium and with the same tools.
