At least 3 primary colors  
Jacquard or Ranger inks

yellow, red, blue

(if Piñata brand: Baja Blue, Senorita Magenta, Sunshine Yellow)

and other of your favorite alcohol ink colors

YUPO paper o 5x7

plastic, or latex free, gloves

inks stains wear old clothes

q-tips

cotton balls or make-up remover cotton pads

Paper towels

91% rubbing alcohol

Small plastic bottles with nibs to store and pour alcohol with or

small air tight container I like the silk painting small bottles with nibs to squeeze alcohol out

small dish or cup to put alcohol in

Liquid Frisket, also called drawing gum, Pebeo is my favorite and small brush

small container for soapy water if using the kind of frisket that you use a brush as application

pencil

transfer paper graphite if possible

white Posca Marker or white gouache paint or acrylic

fine black Micron Permanent Pen

Palette: can be your choice IE. Small round or even a tile to mix inks on
