### Supply List

1 Nara or Yupo paper size 6" x 9"

Cotton balls

Qtips

3-4 paint brushes. Small sizes and medium round

Alcohol for cleaning brushes

Paper towel

Blending solution

Plastic pallets - 2

Posca pen small

Gelly roll white pen small

Pencil to sketch

Carbon paper if you would like to transfer the sketch onto your paper

Prismacolor alcohol in markers optional - Yellow, greens, blues, mulberry

Note: You may use any brand of alcohol inks in shades of blues, oranges, yellows, greens. At least one crimson for the stems.

I use Nara inks, Ranger and Pinata inks.

#### **For Indian Paintbrush flower:**

Ranger Limeade, valencia, dandelion

Pinata Calabaza orange

Greens of your choice

Light yellows of you choice

#### **Bluebonnet flower:**

Crimson red

Glacier blue

Sapphire blue

Indigo

Limeade
